Reserving Qualifying Shifts

We are allowing everyone the ability/option to book any 2 out of 5 qualifying shifts now & until the tournament starts. Once the tournament starts, you can reserve subsequent shifts, any one person can only have a maximum of 2 shifts booked at any one time. Waiting lists will be started as needed & managed accordingly.

(this process is to better help manage shift reservations and will better represent the shifts' actual fullness when posting and advertising. We have added a 5th shift and believe everyone will be able to bowl the desired shifts they want to. We have a total of 320 possible shift entries.)

When booking team entries for the Team Showdown & Baker, please provide a team name along with the team members. We will advise when the team spots are full and payment is required to reserve spots.

Entry fees: Main Event - **\$200** | Team Showdown (3 player) - **\$600** | Baker (4 player) - **\$300**

Main event qualifying shifts will be capped (*note addition of 5th shift & changes in shift start times*):

- Thursday 1:30PM 48 (3 to a lane)
- Friday 8:30AM 64 (4 to a lane)
- Friday 2:00PM 64 (4 to a lane)
- Saturday 8:30AM 64 (4 to a lane)
- Saturday 2:00PM 80 (5 to a lane)

Consolation Event (*note change in day & time*)

- Sunday 8:15AM 48 (*spots 32 to 79 inclusive qualify*)

Championship Matches (*note change in start time*)

- Sunday 10:00AM

Check-In (Qualifying Shifts)

15 minutes prior to the actual shift start time bowlers will be responsible to check-in with the committee staff and draw their lane assignment. Bowlers not checked-in 15 minutes prior to the actual

shift start time will relinquish their reserved spot to the waiting list, if there is one. This applies to both paid and unpaid reserved shifts.

COVID-19

The Regina Classic will be following all Saskatchewan government regulations and as of now proof of vaccination is required. Individuals who do not have a proof of vaccination have the option of providing proof of a valid (e.g., not self administered) negative COVID-19 test result from within the previous 72 hours. Government regulations may change, and we will keep everyone updated if this occurs.
